CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

CHILDREN'S DANCE

...introduces students to the culture and art forms of Africa. Coordination, poly-rhythmic movements and basic positions of West African dance are emphasized. History and language is taught through songs and games.

BEGINNING DRUMMING

...teaches an appreciation for the drum and music of Africa. Students develop rhythmic skills and basic drum techniques.

***Students must provide their own hand drum.**

YOUTH DANCE

...builds on basic dance patterns and incorporates them into sequences. Students learn to use dance as language. An understanding of the partnership between dancer and drummer is formed.

ADULT DANCE

...offers the techniques, terminology, and fundamentals of African dance movement. This class incorporates steps from traditional West African dances into combinations. Students work for stamina and endurance to live accompaniment, not to mention a great aerobic workout.
